



## SWIM ENGLAND QUALIFICATIONS LEVEL 2 BABIES AND TODDLERS COURSE INFORMATION SHEET

### Description

This qualification gives learners the knowledge, skills and confidence to teach babies and toddler swimming lessons if they are already qualified Level 2 Teaching Swimming teacher. It is a practical based qualification which replaces the Level 2 Pre-School Swimming qualification. This qualification links to the Swim England Pre-School Framework, covering Discovery Duckling 1-4 and Duckling 1-4 Awards.

### Role

Once qualified the holder of the Level 2 Babies and Toddlers qualification is able to work independently to plan, prepare, deliver, monitor and evaluate a series of teaching sessions for pre-school aged babies and toddlers.

### Syllabus

As the learner will already hold a SEQ Teaching Swimming or equivalent ASA qualification, the SEQ Level 2 Teaching Swimming to Babies and Toddlers Qualification requires approximately 30 hours of learning time.

This qualification is made up of 18 learning outcomes. On achievement of the qualification the learner will:

1. Understand the legal and safety requirements of teaching swimming to babies and toddlers
2. Know the responsibilities of a Baby and Toddler Swimming Teacher
3. Understand the role of the Baby and Toddler Swimming Teacher in promoting aquatics
4. Understand about the development of babies and toddlers
5. Understand the impact of different types of participants in baby and toddler lessons on lesson delivery
6. Understand the types of equipment used for Baby and Toddler swimming lessons
7. Know about common health related considerations in baby and toddler swimming lessons
8. Understand about supports and holds used in baby and toddler swimming lessons
9. Know about the Core Aquatic Skills needed in baby and toddler swimming lessons
10. Be able to plan baby and toddler swimming lessons
11. Be able to teach baby and toddler swimming lessons
12. Be able to demonstrate lesson management skills
13. Be able to demonstrate communication skills when teaching baby and toddler lessons
14. Be able to use a variety of appropriate teaching methods
15. Be able to demonstrate motivational techniques
16. Be able to assess a pre-school swimming lesson participant
17. Be able to evaluate own performance
18. Be able to plan for professional development

## Pre-requisites

Learners must be at least 16 years of age and hold the SEQ Level 2 Teaching Swimming or equivalent Swim England/ASA qualification.

## Assessment

- All assessment criteria must be achieved
- All evidence produced by the learner must be their own work
- All assessment criteria are assessed by the tutor/assessor
- The assessment is made up of a series of components:
  - Theoretical questions
  - Lesson Plan
  - Lesson Overview (Scheme of Work)
  - Observation record
  - Evaluation
  - Action Plan

## Certification

Once the learner has completed the course and all the assessment criteria have been completed York Swimming Academy Training can forward your results to Swim England Qualifications for certification. Certificates can usually arrive around 3 weeks following the end of the course.
